The charity began in 2008 to provide transitional housing and jobs. It quickly expanded to assist with food, clothes, medical, dental, transportation, education grants, and counseling. We desire to provide compassionate care and opportunities for growth and success in life.

Helping Hands owns and operates two apartment buildings, containing 36 bedrooms (fully furnished). The apartments are in a safe place and provide a friendly and loving environment. We average 40 - 45 residents at any one time. We also operate two Thrift stores which help provide jobs and job training for our residents.

People come to us suffering from childhood abuse, broken relationships, and poverty. Many come feeling rejected, lonely, and scared.
