



Overcoming Trauma, Addiction, and Tragedy through God's Love, Grace, and Power

After 20 years of battling addiction, Susan hit rock bottom and completed a residential treatment program before coming to Helping Hands. The program saved her life.

While in the program, she uncovered the root of where her addiction stemmed from, which was trauma caused by her father in her childhood. Susan said, "To escape the pain and trauma I would spend much of my adulthood using drugs. When these things were brought to light, I began to receive the healing that only God can bring."



Her future looked bright, but with just 4 days from leaving the program the unthinkable happened. She was told that her beautiful four month old twin daughter had passed away from neglect in a foster home. She was devastated. Over the next few months her other twin daughter would be hospitalized from trauma she suffered in the same foster home.

Susan stated, "I would cling to Jesus Christ with everything I had in the months to come. He is the only reason I made it through, as I learned how to deal with my grief and how to live a clean and sober life." In the years to come, she engaged in a fierce battle with DCF to get her surviving daughter and other children free from DCF. DCF told her she would never be reunited with her children. Susan said to us, "God was my strength. I stood on scripture knowing that the truth will always prevail. I maintained my character and was never mean or vindictive. God helped me by reuniting

me with my children through an emergency ruling. Something the department had never done before. Through this journey I learned to persevere, to keep fighting against all odds. What man says is impossible, God says is possible."

Susan has faced other issues since this victory, but has found continued success as she turns to the Lord for wisdom, guidance, and provision.

We are so glad that Susan and her wonderful family have come to be a part of Helping Hands. Susan told us, "I have never been so happy in my life. God has blessed me beyond belief and Helping Hands is a huge part of that. I will not let anything divert me from fulfilling God's purpose for my life. I want to thank Helping Hands and everyone else that has made these opportunities possible for my family and I. Most importantly I want to thank God for always providing for us and giving me the strength to carry on." (Some quotes slightly edited for clarity)
