Jobless, homeless, hospitalized. Cinthia came to us right after being released from the hospital, due to her diabetic condition and her abusive husband withholding her insulin and medications. She

was also jobless and homeless.



An alcoholic father. Cinthia grew up with an alcoholic father that brought strife and struggle to her home. As a young girl, she came upon her father who was dead, and then watched her mother struggle throughout life.

Abusive men. Cinthia was in an abusive ten-year relationship with the father of her daughter. His influence caused her to go to prison shortly after her daughter's birth, but after being released, she returned to him. For the sake of her daughter, she eventually left him. Cinthia eventually met another man, and over the course of time he took her to church and she ended up giving her life to Jesus and getting married to this man. The Lord began changing Cinthia from the inside out for the better, but her husband began abusing her. She ended up in the hospital, which

led to her leaving her husband and coming to Helping Hands for refuge, and an opportunity to build a better life for herself and her daughter.

Thankful for Helping Hands She said, "Since being with Helping Hands I have become employed, being able to do what I went to school for. My mental and physical health is getting so much better. Life for me and my daughter is so peaceful. I'm so blessed to be able to handle everything without depending [on the unhealthy relationship] of a man. I've also learned about myself [through the meetings and interactions with Helping Hands residents], and that fellowship is important to me. It's really taught me that it's okay to open up, especially when it is in a room where the Lord is present." She said her desire is to grow closer to the Lord every day.



Abused and desperate. Having endured physical and emotional abuse from her spouse and an important family member, Desiree said, "I was desperately looking for a safe place ... feeling hopeless ... and trapped in a cycle of abuse."

Answered prayer. In the past, Desiree tried coping with her problems by using alcohol, pills, and partying with the wrong kind of people, but she wanted better for herself and her son. This is when she prayerfully sought help and later found Helping Hands. She says, "when I asked Jesus to help my son and I find a place to sleep, almost instantly we got approved into Helping Hands. My dream was for my son and I to find people who cared, and that is exactly what we found at Helping Hands."

Priorities and Progress. Desiree works very hard as a grounds keeper. She says along with getting her priorities in order, "I now have a loving relationship with our Lord and Savior, Jesus!" Desiree is very kind and a pleasure to be around. She has a beautiful smile, radiates joy and optimism wherever she goes, and now has a hope-filled life.


